This includes professional and clinical supervision of neurophysiology technologists and multidisciplinary team. The position is responsible and accountable for making unit-level decisions and having direct leadership responsibility for contributing to the achievement of the goals of the Clinical Neurophysiology Labs.

The unit manager will initially be participating in the development of the South Health Campus Neurophysiology Lab, and will provide daily support to the multidisciplinary team regarding decision making that will enhance patient and family care that is based on clinical best practice and ensure appropriate resources are utilized in all program areas. The unit manager will facilitate a collaborative approach to care and role model patient and family focused care. The work will involve examining service delivery processes, streamlining where possible, exploring innovative strategies to meet changing patient needs and applying appropriate techniques in quality improvement. The unit manager is responsible for integration of the AHS and South Health Campus vision and mission.
