

ELECTRONEUROPHYSIOLOGY TECHNOLOGIST OPPORTUNITIES IN SASKATCHEWAN

Electroneurophysiology (ENPY) Technologists at the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) work in hospital settings performing outpatient and inpatient testing. Hospital settings include but are not limited to: Intensive Care Units (ICU), Neonatal ICU, Pediatric ICU, Emergency Departments, Seizure Investigation Unit (SIU), and other hospital wards. ENPY technologists primarily work weekday shifts with every third Friday off and may be on call for evenings and weekends.
